

On Feb. 1, we rolled out our Grocery Card Subscription
Program where Stone
Church receives 5% of Weis and Giant Grocery Cards purchased in advance and picked up on the 1st Sunday of each month.

Did you know that you can use Giant Grocery Cards to purchase gasoline for your vehicle? Most folks buy gas somewhere, right? So, if you haven't participated yet ... or are looking for ways to increase your monthly grocery card purchases, give it a try! You may ask, "There's no chip and you can't tap it, so how do you do it?"

- Instead of tapping or dipping for chip-enabled cards, you insert the card like you would to read a chip, with the magnetic strip facing to the right. Then, remove it fairly quickly.
- It will ask, "Do you want to use the whole amount?"
- Reply "yes" and don't worry. It will only deduct the amount of the sale.
- Ask for a receipt at the end and it will show the remaining balance on your Giant Grocery Card (if any).
- If the balance on your card *is not enough* for the entire sale, just reset the cradle that holds the nozzle and run a second transaction with *another* card for the balance.
- The other card can be a credit or debit card or another Giant Grocery Card.
